The undergraduate certificate in Law Enforcement Leadership is designed to enhance leadership and management skills of chiefs of police and other current key state law enforcement command personnel by providing professionally relevant education at the undergraduate level. It offers you an improved understanding of organizational behavior, motivation, change, budget development, labor relations, human resources, and strategic planning.

- Analyze the four phases of the budget cycle.
- Critique the concepts, skills, theories and techniques involving human resource management and HR practices in the workplace.
